Authorization to Release Children in an Emergency

Should there be an emergency, such as a major fire, tornado, explosion, or act of terrorism, your child may be required to remain in the care of the school until it is deemed safe by an Emergency Services authority that the child can be released. At this point, children may be released only to properly authorized parents and/or designees. Therefore, please list as many names, (with local telephone numbers and addresses) as possible, of those persons to whom you would allow your child's release in the event of an emergency. Be sure to notify those persons listed that you have authorized their supervision in case of any emergency.

In the event that you should be unable to come to school, it is essential that others be designated to care for your child. No child will be released to the care of unauthorized persons.
